

**Edward Kasinec** received his M.A. (1968) and M.Phil. (1979) in history from Columbia, his M.L.S from Simmons College (1976), and Certificate in Appraisal Studies from NYU in 2010. In 1971-72 Kasinec studied at the Graduate Faculty of Moscow State University. He began his Harvard career in 1973 as Research Bibliographer, Librarian and Archivist at the Ukrainian Research Institute and Harvard College Library, before moving to University of California, Berkeley in 1980, and NYPL from 1984-2009 [11]. Since 2010 he has served as Research Associate at the Harriman Institute, as well as a Visiting Fellow of the Hoover Institution, Stanford University since 2015. Kasinec has published widely and has lectured and consulted on issues of bibliography and librarianship throughout the world, including at Sapporo University, Hebrew University, and many North American and European institutions.
