

**Orest Deychakiwsky** worked at the U.S. Commission on Security and Cooperation in Europe (Helsinki Commission), an independent US government agency, from November 1981 to May 2017. He had many varied country and issue responsibilities during his tenure, including Ukraine and Belarus. While at the Commission, Orest served as a member of official U.S delegations to numerous conferences and meetings of the Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe (OSCE) and its predecessor, the Conference on Security and Cooperation in Europe (CSCE). He has observed nearly three dozen elections in nine OSCE countries. Orest took the lead or assisted in the drafting of Congressional bills, resolutions, speeches and authored many Helsinki Commission and other publications. He has appeared at various policy and media forums, mostly on Ukraine. Currently, Orest is Co-chair of the Transatlantic Task Force on Ukraine (TTFU) and a Senior Advisor at the U.S.-Ukraine Business Council. He writes a column called “Focus on Washington” for The Ukrainian Weekly. Past NGO activities include Vice-Chairman of the Board of Directors of the U.S.-Ukraine Foundation, long-time Board Member and President of The Washington Group (1998-2000 and Smoloskyp Organization for the Defense of Human Rights in Ukraine. Orest is the recipient of Ukraine's State Order of Yaroslav the Wise and other Ukrainian government awards, and an award from the Government of Bulgaria as well as from various Ukrainian and Belarusian diaspora organizations. Orest's education earned him a B.A. from the University of Notre Dame and an M.A. from Georgetown University in Government and International Relations.
