

Valerii Kuchynskyi is a veteran diplomat from Ukraine. During his professional career, which spans over 35 years, occupied important posts at home and abroad. Member of the Board of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Director-General of the Americas Department, Executive Secretary of the National Commission for UNESCO. He also headed the Department of Arms Control and Disarmament and the Department of International Organizations. Amb. Kuchynskyi has served in numerous bilateral and multilateral appointments in New York, Washington DC, Geneva, in Africa and in the Caribbean. In 2000-2006, he held the position of the Permanent Representative of Ukraine to the United Nations with a diplomatic rank of Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary. He also served as Ukraine's Representative to the UN Commission on Human Rights. Since 2007, after terminating his diplomatic tenure, he has been employed as Adjunct Professor of International and Public Affairs at Columbia University in the City of New York. Amb. Kuchynskyi has authored scores of articles and monographs on UN activities, international relations and foreign policy.
