

Myroslav Shkandrij is Professor Emeritus at the University of Manitoba where he taught Slavic studies. He has published works on the cultural and political history of Ukraine, the avant-garde, nationalism, Jewish-Ukrainian relations, Russian-Ukrainian relations and postcolonial theory. Among his works are *Revolutionary Ukraine, 1917-2017: Flashpoints in History and Contemporary Memory Wars* (New York: Routledge, 2019) and *Avant-garde Art in Ukraine: Contested Memory, 1910-1930* (Boston: Academic Studies Press, 2019). His most recent book, available for sale here at the convention and featured in a book roundtable yesterday, is *In the Maelstrom: The Waffen-SS 'Galicia' Division and Its Legacy*.
