

**Greta Uehling** is a cultural anthropologist who studies war, conflict, and population displacement with a particular focus on the subjective experience of civilians. A professor at the University of Michigan, she currently teaches seminars for the Program in International and Comparative Studies at the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor. Her latest book, *Decolonizing Ukraine* (2025), demonstrates that Crimea and the political, historical, and epistemic marginalization of Crimean Tatars are indispensable to understanding Russian aggression and the war against Ukraine. Her previous book, *Everyday War* (Cornell University Press, 2023), rethinks civilian participation in contemporary conflict and received Harvard University's Davis Book Prize. She is also the author of *Beyond Memory: The Crimean Tatars' Deportation and Return*.
