

Karolina Koziura is a cultural and historical sociologist who studies the legacies of violence, identity-formation processes, and the politics of knowledge in/about Eastern Europe. Karolina received her PhD in sociology and historical studies from the New School for Social Research, New York. Between 2023 and 2025, she was a Max Weber Postdoctoral Fellow at the European University Institute in Florence. Karolina's research was published in, among other places, *Memory Studies*, *East/West: Journal of Ukrainian Studies*, *European Journal of Sociology*, and *East European Politics, Societies, and Culture*. She has been a visiting fellow at, among other places, Konstanz University, Instytut for Human Sciences in Vienna, and the NYU Jordan Center for the Advanced Study of Russia. Currently, she is finishing her first monograph on the transnational politics of recognition surrounding the Holodomor.
