

Marina F. Bykova is a Professor of Philosophy at North Carolina State University and the Editor-in-Chief of Studies in East European Thought. Her research focuses primarily on German idealism – particularly the works of Fichte and Hegel – as well as Russia’s philosophical and intellectual traditions. She has published 14 books and over 260 scholarly articles. Her most recent books include the edited volumes *Hegel’s Philosophy of Nature: A Critical Guide* (Cambridge UP, 2024), *At the Vanishing Point in History. Critical Perspectives on the Russia-Ukraine War* (Bloomsbury, 2025), and *Philosophy Through Its History: The Intellectual Legacy of Nelly V. Motroshilova* (Brill, 2026).
