

Tatiana Krasilnikova is a PhD candidate in Slavic and Comparative Literature at Columbia University, with a graduate certificate in Gender and Sexuality Studies. She is a co-author, with Pavel Uspenskij, of the monograph *Boris Pasternak's Poetic Language: "My Sister—Life" through the Prism of Idioms* (2021) and has published articles on twentieth-century Russian poetry and prose.
